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Stand-out high school track and field athlete ready to make collegiate choice

Clermont, Fla. – Stand-out high school track and field athlete Julie Nunn will announce where she will attend college this fall at a signing event at the National Training Center (NTC) on Saturday, June 5, at 4:00 p.m.

Nunn graduates this year from South Lake High School, where she holds three track and field records including the 100 meter record of 12.20, the 200 meter record of 24.66 and the 400 meter record of 54.75. She was a Florida High School Athletic Association (FHSA) State finalist in the 400 meters all four years of high school.

Her other accolades include being voted Lake County's Girl Track and Field Athlete of the Year in 2010, being voted South Lake High School's Team Most Valuable Player for two years and Most Athletic and receiving the Athlete's Choice Award twice from her school. Nunn also has been at the top of Central Florida's Track Honor Roll for the 400 meter throughout her junior and senior year.

Nunn has been accepted to and offered scholarships from seven colleges including the University of Florida, University of Central Florida, University of South Florida, Florida Atlantic University, Jacksonville University, University of Iowa and University of Kentucky.

Nunn trains at the National Training Center under Coach Dennis Mitchell, a three-time track and field Olympic medalist.

The National Training Center, part of South Lake Hospital, is a state-of-the-art sports complex that includes a 400 meter track and field complex, 70 meter by 25 yard heated outdoor pool, multipurpose fields, 37,000 square foot fitness center, cross country training course, human performance lab, group fitness classes, private Pilates studio, events department, sports performance and coaching, softball/baseball complex and massage.
